



Experience the Aurora and Polar Lights

Come to Abisko and experience the snow-covered arctic mountains under the changing lights of the arctic winter sky.

The dark months of winter is an amazing time to experience the frozen landscape above the arctic circle. December and January is a time when the sun is not seen at all, instead we get pastel colored skies in a dawn that seamlessly melts into dusk. When day turns to night you are not met by complete darkness, instead the polar light show continues. Abisko is a place with minimal light pollution, so it offers you a night sky full of stars and gives you the best chances to see the northern lights dancing on the sky above you. If you come during a full moon you get a whole new perspective on the mountains around you as the gloomy moonlight lights up the snow-covered mountains. This package also gives you an evening at STF Aurora Sky Station, where you get the chance to experience the northern lights from 900 meters elevation, with the Abisko valley and the surrounding mountains as your backdrop.

Experience	You need no prior experience to participate in this package.
Included in your package	
Accommodation	3 nights in a hotel room at STF Abisko Turiststation
Meals	Full board from dinner on the arrival day, until breakfast on departure day. On the evening of day two you will have dinner up at STF Aurora Sky Station
Rental (available as add-on)	You can choose to add a Nordic touring ski package or snowshoe package on day two and/or three (You need to fill out the booking form and e-mail that to Abisko.butik@stfturist.se to secure equipment in your size)
Guide	The evening activity at STF Aurora Sky Station will be led by a guide certified according to the Swedish standard Fjälledarnormen.
Other	The program can be changed due to challenging weather or other unforeseen events. Cancellation can be made up to 7 days before arrival, after that no refunds will be made.

<p>Day 1: 3.00 p.m. – Check-in for your room opens 5.30-7.00 p.m. – Three-course dinner (Notify the restaurant well in advance if you want to change the time for the dinner reservation)</p> <p>Day 2: 7.30-10.00 a.m. – Breakfast buffet 8.00 a.m.-8.00 p.m. – If you chose to add rental equipment you can now pick up Nordic touring skis or snowshoes that you can use during the day. 11.30 a.m.-2.00 p.m. – Lunch buffet 5.30 p.m.-1.00 a.m. – Meet your guide for the walk over to the valley station and the ride up to STF Aurora Sky Station. Once you reach STF Aurora Sky Station you will be served a dinner, and after the dinner, with some luck, you will get to see the northern lights dance on the sky. 1.00 a.m. – Last chair down from STF Aurora Sky Station</p>

8.00 a.m.-8.00 p.m. – If you chose to add rental equipment you can now pick up Nordic touring skis or snowshoes that you can use during the day.

11.30 a.m.-2.00 p.m. – Lunch buffet

5.30-7.00 p.m. – Three-course dinner (Notify the restaurant well in advance if you want to change the time for the dinner reservation)

Day 4:

7.30-10.00 a.m. – Breakfast buffet

10.00 a.m. – Latest time for checking out from your room.

Important information

When booking any of our northern light adventures at STF Aurora Sky Station, we cannot guarantee that you will see the northern lights.

Due to adverse weather conditions; strong winds, very low temperature, blizzards, etc. STF Aurora Sky Station may be closed at short notice for safety reasons. Statistics from previous seasons show that STF Aurora Sky Station is open 90% of the time scheduled and that the Northern Lights have been visible on 70% of the nights when STF Aurora Sky Station was open.

Aurora Lounge

Nothing can replace viewing the Northern Lights from STF Aurora Sky Station, but when weather conditions make it impossible, we offer our guests an alternative program.

NB: No part of the amount paid for a visit to STF Aurora Sky Station will be refunded if your intended visit to STF Aurora Sky Station is replaced by the Aurora Lounge program.

Getting here

The easiest way to get to Abisko is by train. STF Abisko Turiststation has its own train station!

You can also fly to Kiruna, and from there take a bus or the train out to Abisko.
