



## Abisko – First Alpine Skiing Tour

**An alpine skiing tour means making a worthwhile effort to achieve some good skiing. It also means magnificent views, powder snow and unspoiled terrain: a perfect combination of peace, quiet and action.**

On the way up, using climbing skins under our skis and pacing ourselves comfortably, we enjoy the quiet mountains. At the top we take off our climbing skins and enjoy the reward for our efforts - skiing down slopes with a euphoric kick of adrenaline. The area offers a multitude of classic peaks such as Vassitjåkka, Låktatjåkka, Kopparfjell and Kaisepakte that have routes suitable for beginners. Your guide chooses a suitable "mountain of the day" based on prevailing weather and snow conditions.

Finale	STF Abisko Turiststation at 5.00 p.m.
Minimum age	16 years
Experience	When joining this tour, you should at least be able to ski unhindered on blue square slopes, but you do not need any backcountry skiing experience.
<b>Included in your package</b>	
Transportation	Transportation to and from the mountain by minivan.
Rental	<p>Avalanche safety kit is included (transceiver, probe, and shovel).</p> <p>If you need to rent alpine touring equipment you get a 30% discount in the rental of Fjällboden at STF Abisko Turiststation.</p>
Guide	This tour is led by a guide certified according to the Swedish "Fjälledarnorm"
Other	<p>The program can be changed due to challenging weather or other unforeseen events.</p> <p>Cancellation can be made up to 14 days before arrival, after that no refunds will be made.</p>

<b>Important information</b>
<p>When alpine ski touring, we are at the mercy of mother nature. Even though we can in most cases find a sheltered slope and good snow, there are no guarantees, and sometimes we must cancel due to extreme weather conditions. When the tour is cancelled with short notice due to weather, you will get the full amount paid refunded.</p>

The easiest way to get to Abisko is by train. STF Abisko Turiststation has its own train station!

You can also fly to Kiruna, and from there take a bus or the train out to Abisko.
