



STF Aurora Sky Station Northern light dinner

Dine in an unmatched setting!

Abisko offers the best conditions in the world to witness the magnificent northern lights and invites you to a nature experience beyond the ordinary. During the evening, you'll enjoy a delicious four-course dinner featuring flavors from Lapland and Nordic cuisine while the aurora lights up the sky. Our guides will share stories about the northern lights as a phenomenon, about Lapland and its people—the Sami—and the region's ancient traditions and culture.

The evening begins with a two-kilometer chairlift ride up to STF Aurora Sky Station, located 900 meters above sea level, where the dinner is served with sweeping views of Abisko, Lake Torneträsk, and the surrounding mountains. At the Sky Station, there's a large outdoor terrace and a viewing tower where you can take in the northern lights. If you're curious to learn more, you can join the guide's aurora presentation or take a short mountain walk with them.

In the event of severe weather when the lift cannot operate for safety reasons, the dinner will instead be served in our fire-lit Lavvu (Wooden hut), located in a more sheltered part of the national park near STF Abisko Turiststation. After dinner, we'll take short walks through the northern part of the park, guided to the best aurora spots of the evening. Later, warm

drinks and northern delicacies will be served in the Lavvu, with time for further conversation with the guide, who will be happy to share more about the local area, the aurora, and the history of Abisko.

Meeting point	STF Abisko Turiststation at 5.30 p.m. for a walk with your guide to the chairlift. You can also come directly to the chairlift; be there at the latest 6.00 p.m.
Finish	Last lift leaves at 01.00 a.m. Latest 1.30 a.m. at the valley station of the chairlift.
Minimum age	16 years old
Experience	You need no prior experience to participate in this activity
Included in your package	
Equipment	Warm overall and warm boots
Chairlift alt. Wooden Lavvu.	Round-trip travel by chairlift to STF Aurora Sky Station. If weather conditions prevent the chairlift from operating, the event will be moved to the Lavvu, where we offer northern delicacies and warm drinks.
Guide	This tour is led by a guide certified according to the Swedish standard "Fjälledarnormen" (Swedish mountain leader)
Other	The program can be changed due to challenging weather or other unforeseen events. Please see the "Important information" below. Cancellations can be made up to 7 days before arrival, after that no refunds will be made.

Important information
If STF Aurora Sky Station must be closed for safety reasons due to weather conditions, such as strong winds or extreme cold, the event will instead take place in our Lavvu (wooden hut) located in Abisko National Park. The weather has less impact there than up on the mountain, while the chances of seeing the northern lights remain just as good. The decision about the evening's venue will be made on the same day, and all affected guests will be contacted. When booking any of our products at STF Aurora Sky Station, we cannot guarantee that you will see the northern lights, as it is a natural phenomenon. However, if you are staying with us, your chances are very good thanks to the unique cloud conditions in Abisko, often referred to as "the blue hole."

Bookings for any of STF's products at Aurora Sky Station are binding once the cancellation policy comes into effect, and no refunds will be given if the chairlift cannot operate and the event is held in the Lavvu instead.

Getting here

The easiest way to get to Abisko is by train. STF Abisko Turiststation has its own train station!

You can also fly to Kiruna, and from there take a bus or the train out to Abisko.
