



Abisko – Chairlift Tickets (winter)

Take the cable car up to Nuolja and experience the very best that Abisko has to offer. Enjoy fantastic Nordic skiing with breathtaking views of the Abisko Alps and Lake Torneträsk or relax with a pleasant fika at the Aurora Sky Station café and sun terrace.

From Aurora Sky Station, you can also set off on several beautiful nordic ski touring routes. Here you'll experience skiing on the open mountain plateau with stunning views of the Abisko Alps and Lake Torneträsk. Perhaps you'll dare to try "Glidaren," a scenic trail that takes you down gentle slopes into Kårsavagge, and then back to Abisko Tourist Station. Our café is open and offers freshly made waffles, hot drinks, and light snacks.

<p>In the chairlift you will ride a two-seated open chair. The ride up to Aurora Sky Station may take up to 30 minutes. Because of weather conditions we require that you wear warm winter cloths, boots, a hat, and gloves.</p>	

Important information
<p>STF has canceled avalanche control on Nuolja for the winter season 2025/2026. All downhill skiing is therefore undertaken entirely at your own risk. No ski patrol or on-mountain medical services are available.</p> <p>We recommend that anyone planning downhill skiing on Nuolja, or in the mountains in general:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Has appropriate equipment for avalanche terrain.• Plans their trip carefully, taking weather conditions and daylight into account.• Follows the current avalanche forecast at lavinprognoser.se
