# Abisko - Try out alpine ski-touring

An alpine ski touring means making a worthwhile effort to achieve some good skiing. It also means magnificent views, powder snow and unspoiled terrain.

On the way up, using climbing skins under our skis and pacing ourselves comfortably, we enjoy the quiet mountains. At the top we take off our climbing skins and enjoy the reward for our efforts - skiing down slopes with a euphoric kick of adrenaline.

The area offers a multitude of classic peaks such as Vassitjåkka, Låktatjåkka, Kopparfjell and Kaisepakte that have routes suitable for beginners. Your guide chooses a suitable "mountain of the day" based on prevailing weather and snow conditions.

Minimum age	16 years old in company of a guardian
Experience	When joining this tour, you should be able to ski unhindered on red slope, but you do not need any off- piste skiing experience.
Participants	Min 1/Max 8



Included in your package	
Transportation	Transportation to and from the mountain by minivan.
Equipment	Avalanche safety kit is included (transceiver, probe, and shovel).
Guide	This tour is led by a guide certified according to the Swedish "Fjälledarnorm"
Other	The program can be changed due to challenging weather or other unforeseen events.
	Cancellations can be made up to 7 days before arrival, after that no refunds will be made.

#### Important information

When alpine ski touring, we are at the mercy of mother nature. Even though we can in most cases find a sheltered slope and good snow, there are no guarantees, and sometimes we must cancel due to extreme weather conditions. When the tour is cancelled with short notice due to the weather, you will get the full amount refunded.

Equipment included (Divided between the participants)	<ul> <li>Bivy bag</li> <li>Avalanche equipment (transceiver, probe, shovel)</li> <li>First aid kit (guide)</li> </ul>	
Recommended equipment	<ul> <li>Randonée-, telemark- or splitboard equipment (with climbing skins) for riding off-piste</li> <li>Ski-/snowboard boots (with walk-mode)</li> <li>Ski poles</li> <li>Helmet</li> <li>Base layer, wool or synthetic</li> <li>Warm layer in fleece, wool or softshell</li> <li>Shell clothing without insulation (the jacket should have a helmet-compatible hood)</li> <li>Skiing socks (preferably woolen or with a wool mix)</li> <li>Warm layer for breaks (light down- or synthetic jacket)</li> <li>2 pairs of gloves/mittens</li> <li>Beanie and/or headband/buff (for the uphill)</li> <li>Thermos and water bottle</li> </ul>	



	<ul> <li>Sunglasses and ski goggles</li> <li>Sun cream</li> <li>Sports tape (for blister prevention)</li> <li>Backpack, 35-45L (suitable for ski-touring, so it can carry your probe, shovel, and helmet)</li> </ul>
Nice to have	Sitting pad
Rental of equipment	Rental of equipment for this activity such as skis is not included in the price and needs to be booked separately. If you need to rent equipment it can be rent at our Shop & Rental Fjällboden with a 15% discount as a member of this tour.
