



STF Aurora Sky Station Night Visit

The world's most illuminating experience!

Abisko has the world's best conditions to experience fantastic northern lights and offers you a nature experience beyond the ordinary. Our guides will take you to the best places to experience the magical Northern Lights dancing in the sky and tell you about the Northern Lights as a phenomenon, about Lapland and its inhabitants, the Sami people and the region's ancient traditions and culture.

The evening begins with a two-kilometre journey by chairlift up to STF Aurora Sky station at an altitude of 900 metres with miles of views of Abisko, Torneträsk and the mountain landscape. It features an outdoor terrace and lookout tower where guests can experience the Northern Lights. If you want to learn more, you have the chance to listen to the guide's Northern Lights presentation that is held during the evening, and you can also join your guide on a shorter hike on the mountain. Inside STF Aurora Sky Station, you can relax in front of the fireplace in the cosy café while waiting for the Northern Lights, where you can buy coffee, drinks and souvenirs.

In severe weather when the cable car cannot be run for safety reasons, we instead start from our cozy Laavu (wooden tipi) which is located in the national park and more weather-protected adjacent to STF Abisko Tourist Station. We do a shorter hike in the

northern part of the national park together with our guide who takes us to the evening's best places for northern lights spotting. Hot drinks and snacks in the form of delicious northern delicacies are served in the lavvu.

Information	
Meeting point	STF Abisko Turiststation at 8.30 p.m. for a guided walk to the chairlift. You can also come directly to the chairlift at 9.00 p.m.
Finish	Last lift leaves at 01.00 a.m. Latest 1.30 a.m. at the valley station of the chairlift.
Minimum age	12 years old
Experience	You need no prior experience to participate in this activity
Included in your package	
Equipment	Warm overall and warm boots
Chairlift alt. Wooden Lavvu.	Round-trip travel by chairlift to STF Aurora Sky Station. If weather conditions prevent the chairlift from operating, the event will be moved to the Lavvu, where we offer northern delicacies and warm drinks.
Guide	This tour is led by a guide certified according to the Swedish standard "Fjälledarnormen" (Swedish mountain leader)
Other	The program can be changed due to challenging weather or other unforeseen events. Please see the "Important information" below. Cancellations can be made up to 7 days before arrival, after that no refunds will be made.

Important information
If STF Aurora Sky Station must be closed for safety reasons due to weather conditions, such as strong winds or extreme cold, the event will instead take place in our Lavvu (wooden Sami tent) located in Abisko National Park. The weather has less impact there than up on the mountain, while the chances of seeing the northern lights remain just as good. The decision about the evening's venue will be made on the same day, and all affected guests will be contacted. When booking any of our products at STF Aurora Sky Station, we cannot guarantee that you will see the northern lights, as it is a natural phenomenon. However, if you are staying with us, your chances are very good thanks to the unique cloud conditions in Abisko, often referred to as "the blue hole." Bookings for any of STF's products at Aurora Sky Station are binding once the cancellation policy comes into effect, and no refunds will be given if the chairlift cannot operate and the event is held in the Lavvu instead.

Getting here

The easiest way to get to Abisko is by train. STF Abisko Turiststation has its own train station!

You can also fly to Kiruna, and from there take a bus or the train out to Abisko.
