



STF Aurora Sky Station Night Visit

The world's most illuminating experience!

Abisko offers the world's best conditions for experiencing the northern lights and invites you to a nature experience beyond the ordinary. During the evening, you'll be treated to a delightful four-course dinner featuring flavors from Lapland and the Nordic kitchen, all while the northern lights dance across the sky. Our guides will share insights about the aurora as a phenomenon, about Lapland and its inhabitants, the Sami people, and the region's ancient traditions and culture.

The evening begins with a two-kilometer ride by chairlift up to the STF Aurora Sky Station, located at 900 meters above sea level, where the dinner is enjoyed with sweeping views of Abisko, Lake Torneträsk, and the surrounding mountain landscape. At the STF Aurora Sky Station, there is a large outdoor terrace and a viewing tower where you can witness the northern lights. If you want to learn more, you'll have the opportunity to attend the guide's northern lights presentation held during the evening, and you can also join the guide for a short mountain walk.

In case of severe weather, when the chairlift cannot operate for safety reasons, dinner will be served in our fire-lit Lavvu (wooden hut), located within the national park in a more sheltered area near STF Abisko Turiststation. After dinner, we'll take a short walk through the northern part of the national park with our guide, who will lead us to the best viewing

spots for northern lights that evening. Later in the evening, warm drinks and delicious northern delicacies will be served in the Lavvu, where there's also an opportunity for further conversation with the guide, who will be happy to share more about the local area, the aurora, and Abisko's history. With the meal, we offer selected wine pairings, beer, or non-alcoholic beverages available for purchase.

Meeting point	STF Abisko Turiststation at 8.30 p.m. for a guided walk to the chairlift. You can also come directly to the chairlift at 9.00 p.m.
Finish	Last lift leaves at 01.00 a.m. Latest 1.30 a.m. at the valley station of the chairlift.
Minimum age	12 years old
Experience	You need no prior experience to participate in this activity
Included in your package	
Equipment	Warm overall and warm boots
Chairlift alt. Wooden Lavvu.	Round-trip travel by chairlift to STF Aurora Sky Station. If weather conditions prevent the chairlift from operating, the event will be moved to the Lavvu, where we offer northern delicacies and warm drinks.
Guide	This tour is led by a guide certified according to the Swedish standard "Fjälledarnormen" (Swedish mountain leader)
Other	The program can be changed due to challenging weather or other unforeseen events. Please see the "Important information" below. Cancellations can be made up to 7 days before arrival, after that no refunds will be made.

Important information
<p>If STF Aurora Sky Station must be closed for safety reasons due to weather conditions, such as strong winds or extreme cold, the event will instead take place in our Lavvu (wooden Sami tent) located in Abisko National Park. The weather has less impact there than up on the mountain, while the chances of seeing the northern lights remain just as good. The decision about the evening's venue will be made on the same day, and all affected guests will be contacted.</p> <p>When booking any of our products at STF Aurora Sky Station, we cannot guarantee that you will see the northern lights, as it is a natural phenomenon. However, if you are staying with us, your chances are very good thanks to the unique cloud conditions in Abisko, often referred to as "the blue hole."</p>

Bookings for any of STF's products at Aurora Sky Station are binding once the cancellation policy comes into effect, and no refunds will be given if the chairlift cannot operate and the event is held in the Lavvu instead.

Getting here

The easiest way to get to Abisko is by train. STF Abisko Turiststation has its own train station!

You can also fly to Kiruna, and from there take a bus or the train out to Abisko.
