



Abisko – Wood heated sauna

Our wood heated sauna sits on the banks of lake Torneträsk. Here you can let your eyes gaze at the magnificent surroundings and your spirit fly free.

At lake Torneträsk you are surrounded by endless mountains and wild nature. In winter you can experience a cold swim in the prepared ice hole and in summer a refreshing swim from the shore, just outside the sauna. A genuine Nordic experience, a true sauna of the North! You and your party have the sauna at your own disposal and the price includes up to ten persons.

Information	
Meeting point	STF Abisko Turiststation at 3:30 p.m. (the sauna is ready at 4:00 p.m.)
Finale	STF Abisko Turiststation at 6:00 p.m.
Good to know	You need to pick up the key to the sauna from the reception before heading down to the lake. The hike down to the sauna is 1 km and takes around 20 minutes.

Included in your package	
Sauna	Private sauna for up to ten people. If you are more than ten people there is an additional fee (295 SEK / extra person).
Pre-heating	Our staff will pre-heat the sauna for you, so it is good to go when you arrive. There will be lots of wood for you to keep the fire going after your arrival.
Towels	There will be towels on site for everyone in your group.
Cleaning	Once you are done in the sauna, we will take care of the cleaning.
Booking conditions	Cancellations can be made up to 7 days before arrival, after that no refunds will be made.
