ABOUT THE AREA

Abisko is located 250 km north of the Arctic Circle and attracts visitors from all over the world to experience the polar nights in winter, where the northern lights dance across the sky in winter, and the endless light of the midnight sun in summer.

The tourist station is situated in one of Sweden's first national parks – Abisko National Park – and serves as the perfect starting point for those who want to stay comfortably while exploring the magnificent nature. To the south, the Kungsleden trail stretches between the iconic Lapporten – known as Čuonjaváaggi in Sami – and Mount Njulla on the other side. To the north, just before the Norwegian border, lies Scandinavia's largest alpine lake, Torneträsk. From here, you can join guided tours, rent equipment, or get help planning your own adventure. With its unique combination of dramatic landscapes, accessible outdoor activities, polar phenomena, and biological diversity, Abisko is a place that inspires and touches the soul.

FIND YOUR WAY HERE

The easiest way to travel to Abisko is by train, as the platform is located right outside the tourist station.

Another option is to fly to Kiruna and continue by bus or train to Abisko.
